Aslon® Demarcation tiles

Aslon® demarcation tiles are water-permeable, hard-wearing and made of recycled rubber granulate. These rubber tiles can be used on flat roofs, except of PVC roofing, to create a walkway. The technical installations are therefore easily accessible for maintenance and repairs. This ensures that the roof is protected and reduces the risk of slipping due to the non-slip surface. The hard-wearing yellow lining makes it possible to demarcate the safe zone, there are several types of lines available. The tiles have a size of 120 x 60 cm, so less tiles are needed compared to a standard size.

Aslon® demarcation tiles are available with dowel joints. On two edges of each tile there are four holes. Four plastic pins are inserted into these holes allowing the tiles to be joined together.
